- Will join Class Dojo as a means to communicate with your child's teacher.



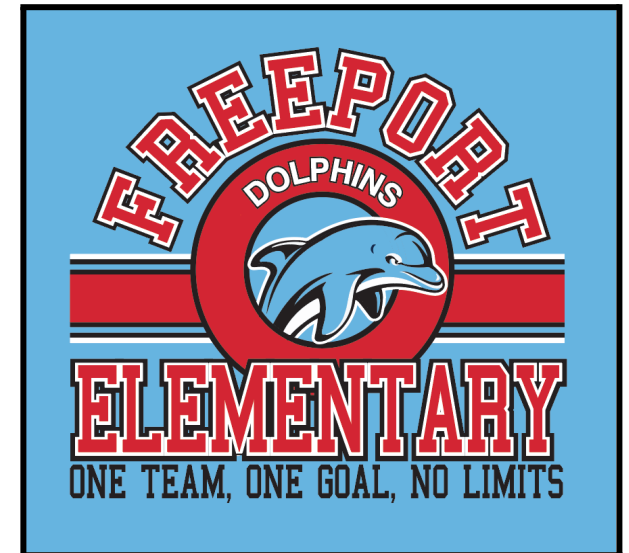
## Students

## School Goals

- 1.) 85% of PK-Students will be able to identify upper and lower case letters and be able to produce 100% of the letter sounds by the EOY.
- 2.) K-2nd grade students will perform on grade level or above and/or show one year's growth for Reading and Math at the end of the year as measured by the district screeners.
- 3.) By the end of the school year, 85% of K students will read on Level 3, 85% of 1st grade students will read on Level 16, and 85% of 2nd grade students will read on Level 24.

## Focus Areas:

- 1.) Students reading on grade level by the end of the school year, or show a year's worth of growth on district screeners/DRA.
- 2.) Students will be able to perform on grade level in Math.
- 3.) Teachers and staff will teach social skills that are needed for students to be successful at school.

## Teachers

- Will model instruction and provide parents with reading materials and strategies, including our SMARTIE folder.
- Will send home a daily communication folder and/or use Class Dojo to communicate with parents.
- Will host school wide math and literacy family nights annually.



## Communication about Student Learning

Freeport Elementary is committed to frequent two-way communication with families about children's learning. Some of the ways you can expect us to reach you are:

- Newsletters, parent/ teacher conferences, personal contacts and written notices will be written in English and Spanish to establish and maintain an open line of communication. Social media (Facebook, Class Dojo, and/or take home folders) will be utilized to inform our parents of events and happenings on campus.
- Report cards 4 times a year for K-2nd grades and 3 times a year for Pre-K
- Personal notes or phone calls from teacher and communication through Class Dojo
