The purpose of this letter is to properly inform you per state requirements that 2019 STAAR testing results will be available to view online in the state of Texas Student Assessment Portal, which can be found by going to www.texasassessments.com. By using the directions enclosed with this letter, you will be able to go online using a computer or smart device to access your child’s scores the moment they become available. You will also be able to view your child’s entire state testing history. The current state schedule for the release of 2019 STAAR test scores is as follows:

Date of Release to Student Portal	STAAR Tests Scores Released
Tuesday, April 30, 2019	5th & 8th Math & Reading (1st Administration)
Thursday, May 30, 2019	STAAR Algebra, Biology, US History, English I, English II
Wednesday, June 5, 2019	5th & 8th Math & Reading (Retest)
Wednesday, June 12, 2019	STAAR 3-8 All Subjects
Wednesday, July 17, 2019	5th & 8th Math & Reading (Summer Retest)
Monday, July 29, 2019	STAAR Algebra, Biology, US History, English I, English II (Summer Retest)

Once you log into the Texas Student Assessment Portal and access your child’s results, what do the scores mean? Use the table below to help you understand the following terms:

Masters Grade Level	Passing Score	Means that your child is expected to succeed in the next grade level or course with little or no academic intervention. Formerly known as advanced.
Meets Grade Level	Passing Score	Means that your child has a high likelihood of success in the next grade or course but may still need some short-term intervention.
Approaches Grade Level	Passing Score	Means that your child met the assessment requirements for promotion and is considered to have met at least the minimum passing standard.
Does Not Meet Grade Level	Not a Passing Score	Means that your child did not meet the minimum passing standard for that assessment. Students at this level will need significant academic intervention.
