Our primary focus is to provide students with the necessary resources, tools, and real world skills that give them the opportunity to be successful in school and beyond the classroom.




What We Do

Communities In Schools partners with school districts, educators, parents and community partners to identify barriers to address the students needs. After the needs are identified, CIS provides support for students and families by providing individual case management services.



BEHAVIOR:

Self-esteem, social skills, work habits, anger management and goal setting.



ACADEMICS:

Tutoring reminders, monitoring grades, in class support, one-on-one academic support. STAAR encouragement as needed.

We check students grades & attendance every 9 weeks.



ATTENDANCE:

Home visits, parent phone calls, monitor absences







SOCIAL SERVICES:

School supplies, clothes, vsp vouchers, backpack buddy, agency referrals, etc.

Steps

1)Student Recommendation Form

- Teacher, Nurse, Parent, Student, Brazoswood Staff, CIS Coordinator
- It can be done by email (one student per email)

2) Parent Consent

 The student is allowed to attend only <u>ONE</u> group without a parent consent.

I can not work with a student unless I have a parent consent.

Resources

- Sight for Students VSP Vision Program- vision testing and glasses certificates available.
- CIS Closet- School Supplies, Hygiene Products, Clothing, Shoes, Snacks, and Water.
- ❖ Backpack Buddy- Pick up location for main campus on Fridays. Parents can pick up at 8am-9am on Fridays.
- Emergency Funds Request- CIS can help with rent & utilities but it must be past due in order to prevent eviction.
- United Way- Rapid Rehousing- they must have a job in order to qualify

- United Way- help with rent & utilities, employment and resources for health.
- ❖ Community Health Network- Income based, Dental, Visionworks Brazos Mall (VSP Vouchers), Health, Women's Health and Mental/ Behavior Health
- *Brazoria County Medication Assistance Program- Helps with Medicine for 18 years or older.
- Brazosport Medical Center- assist low income without insurance.
- Salvation Army- help with rent and Christmas help (the family needs to register on their own)


FUNDRAISER
